Pattern notes:

A right-hand (RH) triangle is what the pattern calls a half form that is worked at the beginning of a RS row. **A RH triangle adds 1 stitch to the stitch count.**

RH triangle: with RS facing, K to last stitch, KFB. Next row, (WS) K to end. Next row, (RS), K 24 stitches, W&T. K back to the straight edge. (Remember to strand the yarn up the side at the beginning of each new row.) Row 1: K to 2 sts before last wrap, W&T. Row 2: K back to straight edge. Repeat these 2 rows until there are 2 sts remaining.

A left-hand (LH) triangle is what the pattern calls a half form that is worked at the beginning of a WS row. **A LH triangle adds 13 stitches to the stitch count.**

(LH) triangle: RS: K to last st, KFB. Row 1: (WS) K21, W&T, K to last st, KFB. Row 2: (RS) K to 2 sts before wrap, W&T. Repeat these 2 rows 11 more times (for a total of 12 W&T's) **until there are 10 stitches left**, then K to the end of WS row.

A full-leaf (FL) can be started on the WS or RS row, beginning at different positions as indicated in the pattern. **A FL adds 1 stitch to the stitch count.**

(FL):

Set-up row:: Knit 20 sts, W&T.

Row 1: Knit 20 sts, W&T.Mis

Row 2: Knit 22 sts, W&T.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 11 more times (12 wraps), last row 2, K to end (no W&T).

Simplified Garter Stitch Wrap & Turn:

Slip stitch PURLWISE with yarn in back.

Bring yarn to front and turn work.

Slip stitch PURLWISE and continue knitting.

To pick up wraps:

Knit to wrapped stitch

Insert right needle under the wrap, from the front, and slip it OVER the stitch on left needle, so it is positioned BEHIND the stitch on the left needle.

Knit the 2 stitches together TBL
